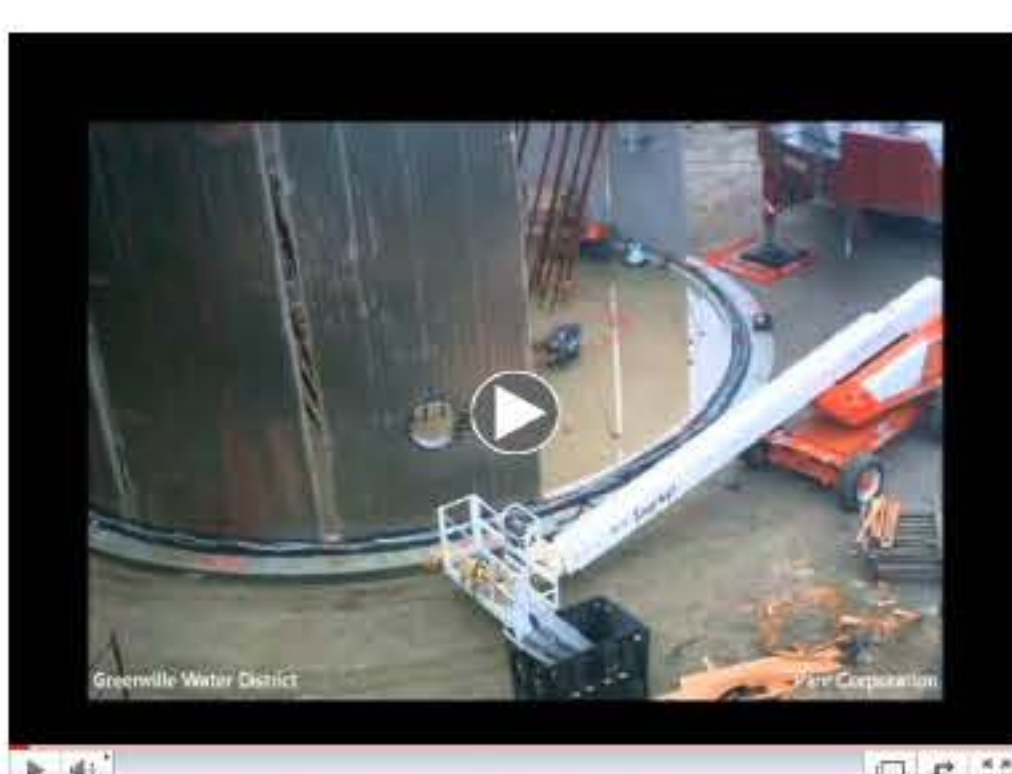
**Pare Receives Bronze Award at ACEC/MA Awards**
